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


Figure 1: Word cloud of stories' claims. Word cloud generated using the library WORD-CLOUDS (default settings, maximal word size constrained). We introduced the following set of additional stop words: 'say', 'said', 'says', 'will', 'people', 'shows', 'show', 'photograph', 'photo' and 'video'.




Figure 2: Flowchart of the data collection process.




Figure 3: Relevant distributions concerning the data collection process. (a) KDE for the (minimal) number of attempts per story to identify a query. (b) Empirical complementary cumulative distribution function of the number of subqueries. (c) The distribution of the number of baselines.
